

Affirmation,
First Notice of Existence,
Bilateral Social Compact Agreement
by and between the People
of the State of Florida, County of Volusia, in The united States of America

Preamble

We the People, in God We trust, agree that the great and essential principles of rightful liberty and freedom are recognized and established within this Bilateral Social Compact Agreement, the essential rights and rightful liberty for the People within the metes and bounds and seaward boundaries of The State of Florida, County of Volusia, within The United States of America. The fifty-several respective States of the Union are hereby accepted and acknowledged with this Bilateral Social Compact. This Agreement acknowledges that the Constitution for the united States of America, the Law of the Land, guarantees a Republic form of Government for each of the several States in perpetual Union; and

On this 8th day of March 2025, We the People in our unalienable image, men and women assembled in the State of Florida, County of Volusia, hereby deny any trespass upon our unalienable image and or rights thereof. We the People have hereby declared our independence and stand on our rights to protect life, rightful liberty, private property, and the *pursuit of happiness*. Our God given natural rights are endowed upon us by our Creator, and no inhabitant, person, and or People may remove or trespass upon those rights. Our natural rights are superior to any man made orders, statutes, or codes; and

We the People agree that our Lawful Civil Authority is evidenced by the following:

- The accurate “Holy Bible,” and;
- The *Mayflower Compact, circa 1620*
- Vattel, Emmerich de, *The Law of Nations or the Principles of Natural Law, circa 1758*; and
- *The Declaration of Independence, circa 1776*; and
- *An Ordinance for the Government of the Territory of the United States North-West of the River Ohio* (Northwest Ordinance) as codified in *1 Statute 50* and as implemented by We the People of the *Republic for the united States of America*; and
- *The Constitution for the united States of America, circa 1787*; and
- *The Atlantic Charter, 1941, Joint declaration by Franklin D. Roosevelt and Winston Churchill*; and
- The “*Proclamation of Claim and Interest of the Republic for the united States of America*,” as these precedents prove that we do, in fact, have the lawful right to re-inhabit our original constitutional government.

Article 1

We the People agree that all People in the State of Florida, County of Volusia, a State in The Union within The United States of America, when they form a Bilateral Social Compact Agreement are on an equal footing with all men and that we are *endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness*; and have certain inherent and indefeasible immunities that are also guaranteed by the Bilateral Social Compacts created by other men domiciled within the other several States of The Union (doctrine of parity,) among which are those of enjoying and defending life and rightful liberty; of acquiring, possessing, and protecting property and reputation; and of pursuing their own happiness. In other words, We the People are on "Equal Footing" with the other People who are domiciled in other States; we are not on “Equal Footing” with the States which they created; we are the creators of said States and, as a People, have Superior Standing in Law, not “Equal Footing” over the States that We the People created;

We the people of Volusia who are making this notice public with intent on operating in the de jure as best we know how.
